



## Dear 4-H Camp Families,

We are so excited to have you attend 4-H Junior High Camp May 26 - 30, 2025 at the York 4-H Center in Crossville, TN. A detailed schedule will be distributed at check-in on May 26th. To help you prepare, we are sending this helpful packet of information. Please read it carefully, review it with your members, and contact your local agent if you have any questions. Included you will find:

- Map to the 4-H Center
- o 2025 Centers, Gift Shop, and Canteen Prices
- o Summer Camp Menu- any questions about food should be directed directly to the 4-H Center: 931-788-2288. The summer camp menu is tentative and subject to change.
- o **Bead Pamphlet** Campers may earn beads based on participation.
- o Packing List Cell phones are NOT allowed for campers. All communication must be through the 4-H Center.
- o Mailing Procedures Campers can send or receive mail while at 4-H Camp.
- Behavior Management Rules set by the University of Tennessee and Clyde York 4-H Center
- Dress Code Guidelines
- o F600A (campers/teens) or F600B (adults or agents) that has been checked by your local 4-H agent.
  - o Every F600A and F600B must:
    - Have a current photo glued or taped:
    - Include a copy of the front and back of insurance card;
    - Must be completely filled out;
    - Must be uploaded to their SUPER profile by your county extension office.
- o F600M The updated medical form also allows 4 5 medicines to be placed on one sheet.
  - Medication must not be expired;
  - It must be in the original container;
  - o Form must be complete and placed in a Ziplock bag with the medication;
  - o All medications must be distributed by camp staff.
- o F600R If your child is leaving at a different time, this form must be on file.
- o F600A & F600M These forms MUST be uploaded in SUPER two (2) weeks prior to arrival at camp.

## Check-In

- Check-in for agents, adult volunteers, and teen leaders will begin at 9:30 AM on May 26<sup>th</sup>.
  - Agents will utilize this time to prepare for their week at camp.
- Check-in for campers will happen at designated times to help ease traffic flow.

The gates will not open prior to this time. You will enter the facility via Maple Drive.

- Check-in will begin from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM for the following counties: Clay, Dekalb, Jackson, Lincoln, Macon, Overton, Pickett, Putnam, Sequatchie, Smith, Van Buren, Warren, White, Wilson
- O Check-in will be from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM for the following counties: Bedford, Cannon, Cheatham, Coffee, Davidson, Franklin, Giles, Grundy, Marion, Marshall, Maury, Moore, Robertson, Rutherford, Sumner, Trousdale, Williamson

- During camper check-in, all bags must remain in your vehicle.
- You will enter through the main gate. There will be signs and teens directing traffic and handing you a passport to get signed at each spot.
- The first stop for all campers will be in the Recreation (Rec) Hall (building 4), which is the first building on the right.
  - o Boys on the left / girls will line up on the right, and your F600A will be reviewed.
  - o Campers will be given their cabin assignment.
  - o Next, move towards the back of the Rec Hall for your medical screening.
    - Camper will be inspected for lice, checked for a fever, and will discuss any needs.
    - An agent will check your F600M and take any medications.
- Once your passport is signed, you can then take your luggage to your assigned cabin.
- There will be tables outside cabins 1, 2, and 3 for females (Red Bud Square 7 on Map) and cabins 5 and 6 for males (Dogwood Square 8 on Map).
- You will receive a 4-H shirt, a copy of the schedule, and a map here. Parents or guardians
  may help kids unpack and get set up for the week--however, no males in female cabins or
  females in male cabins.
- Once checked in, parents or guardians should exit the facility promptly to allow space for more than 200 campers we'll be hosting. Be careful when entering and exiting. You will exit the facility on Hope Road. This is highlighted on the map.
- Lunch will be available for campers from 11:45 AM to 1:00 PM in the Dining Hall (building 2).
- All campers will report to the Rec Hall at 1:15 PM.
- While campers wait for camp to begin, they are welcome to utilize facilities where camp staff, agents, adult leaders, or teen leaders are present. This area will include the space between the Dining Hall, Rec Hall, and Canteen. Cabins will be locked after check-in is complete, and until the next break.

## Check-Out:

- Check-out out will begin once all cabins are clean, every camper has had their medications, and camp staff has approved us. Check-out will happen at the basketball court at 10:00 AM.
- All Junior High Campers will stay in the Dining Hall during this process.
- The parent or guardian on the F600A must be the person to pick up or we must have the F600R designating who is picking up.


